## MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

OF

## THE SALVATION ARMY

1. The name of the Association (hereinafter called "the Association") is "THE SALVATION ARMY".
2. The Registered Office of the Association will be situated in the State of Bombay.
3. The Objects for which the Association is established are :-
  - (A) To carry out and promote in the Union of India all or such religious and charitable objects and purposes of the organization founded in England by William Booth and known as The Salvation Army (hereinafter referred to as "the Army") and other aims and enterprises subsidiary or contributory to such objects and purposes as may from time to time be determined or approved by the General for the time being of the Army (hereinafter referred to as "the General").
  - (B) To acquire, take over, receive, hold, and administer all moveable or immovable property in India now in the custody of or standing in the name of the Salvation Army Property Co. Ltd., and all or any other property now or hereafter belonging to the Army and applicable for or in aid of the religious or charitable objects or purposes of the Army or any other charitable purposes under the direction or control of the General and to apply and dispose of all such property in accordance with the trusts applicable thereto respectively.

## LICENCE

Licence under Section 26 of the Indian Company Act, 1913

WHEREAS, it has been proved to the Government of Bombay that "The Salvation Army" which is about to be registered under the Indian Companies Act, 1913, as amended from time to time, is formed for the purposes *inter alia* of promoting in India the religious and charitable objects of the organization founded in England by William Booth and known as "The Salvation Army"; and in particular to take over and administer all moveable and immoveable property in India now standing in the name of the Salvation Army Property Company Limited, in aid of the religious and charitable objects of The Salvation Army and to accept subscriptions and contributions and to take necessary steps to procure such subscriptions or donations. It is the intention of "The Salvation Army" that the income and property of the Association whencesoever derived shall be applied solely for or towards the promotion of the objects of the Association as set forth in its Memorandum and that no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend or bonus or otherwise howsoever by way of profit to the members of the Association.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Government of Bombay by this licence is pleased to direct, under the provisions of Section 26 of the Indian Companies Act, 1913, as amended from time to time, that "The Salvation Army" be registered as a Company with limited liability without the addition of the word "Limited" to its name.


The Licence is granted subject to the conditions and regulations which are contained in the Memorandum of the said Association as subscribed by the Members thereof a copy of which is herewith annexed.
